The following information relates to the processing of personal data in connection with the ACHEMA PULSE 2021 online event to be held on the Event Community & Management platform talque.com.

3. Type and Scope of Processing of Personal Data

We will process your data for the purpose of taking part and fulfilling the Achema PULSE. The purpose of the online event is to encourage B2B contacts (also known as matchmaking). This takes into account in particular the exchange opportunities between participants, speakers and exhibitors on and outside the talque.com platform.

The DECHEMA Ausstellungs-GmbH event will be carried out as a virtual event with the talque digital event platform of Real Life Interaction GmbH. Participation is possible only following registration with talque. Registration is independent of any specific online event and after ACHEMA PULSE 2021 remains a separate matter under the sole responsibility of Real Life Interaction GmbH.

The controllers divide the data processing steps as follows:

Process Step 6	Transfer of the event-specific data to DECHEMA Ausstellungs-GmbH	Real Life Interaction GmbH

The data is processed for the purpose of fulfilling the contract pursuant to Article 6(1) (b) GDPR. Unless other duties of storage and documentation are set forth in Article 6 (1) (c) GDPR, the collected data will be deleted after their purpose has been fulfilled, unless in an individual case you have consented to further storage in a separate declaration pursuant to Article 6 (1) (a) GDPR.

The storage of the talque chat and personal core data still under the sole responsibility of Real Life Interaction GmbH after ACHEMA PULSE 2021 will only cease by means of erasure if the user consciously closes his user account or issues authorization for this action.

4. Passing On of Data to Recipients

For the purpose of the online event, data will be disclosed to the providers of technical and other services, especially computer centres, which the controllers shall employ as processors without exception. These shall act under the supervision and on instructions from the controller.

The other category of recipients whose data will be disclosed consists in the other participants of the online event. These are third parties in relation to the participants, and therefore solely responsible for the further handling of their data. Nonetheless, disclosures are limited to other participants with whom you have interacted during the online event. If you interact during the online event with participants domiciled outside the European Union or in a so-called third country, we shall also transfer the data there for the purpose of fulfilling the contract with you. You shall be notified if it has been established that the level of data protection in third countries has not reached a reasonable standard in comparison with the level offered in the European Union. Interactions are: Participation in sessions, workshops, livestreams, presentations, and individual contact with an exhibitor or other participant (video calls, chats, requests for information, and the like). Insofar as your data is disclosed by us to other participants, the data may be used by them consequently for the purpose of commercial communication with you.

5. Your Rights as Data Subject

Vis-a-vis the controller you have the

- **Right of access**, (Article 15 GDPR), to your personal data which we process,
- **Right to rectification** (Article 16 GDPR) of incorrect data stored by us,
- **Right to erasure** (Article 17 GDPR) under the conditions provided therein,
- **Right to restriction** of further processing of personal data (Article 18 GDPR);
- **Right to data portability** (Article 20 GDPR), the right to receive the personal data which you provided to us previously, in a structured, commonly-used and machine-readable format and the right to transmit those data to another controller and
- if you agreed to processing in a separate declaration, the **right of objection**, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing carried out prior to the objection.

Regarding the data processing carried out under their joint responsibility, the joint controllers agree that the controller against whom rights are asserted is obliged to provide the data subject with information and promptly forward demands for correction, erasure or other requests promptly to the other controller

6. Your Right of Complaint

You have the right, pursuant to Article 77 DVSG, to approach a data supervisory authority at any time.

Because the joint controllers have agreed internally that Real Life Interaction GmbH is the main office responsible for the data processing on behalf of the joint controllers. 7. Duties of Provision and Automated Decision-Making
